



## PROJECT: GOLDMAN SACHS WORLD HEADQUARTERS

**Project Description:** Remco spray painted and clear coated wood doors and panels.

**Location:** 200 West Street New York, NY

**Building:** The Goldman Sachs new World Headquarters building is a 740-ft tall, 43-story building under construction in Battery Park City that officially broke ground in 2005. The Goldman Sachs building was designed by Pei Cobb Freed & Partners, and is a LEED-certified green building. The project has received \$1 billion in Liberty Bonds, which provide tax-free financing. The building opened in the later part of 2009.

**Scope of Work:** As part of the post construction punch list work, Remco was contracted to repair damaged areas and to correct the uneven factory finish rejected by the architect and provide a uniform finish to various wood panels and closet doors throughout the building. Remco's work consisted of sanding panels and doors, the application of two coats of a special metallic coating and two coats of clear topcoat while sanding and tacking in between each coat to ensure proper adhesion. Remco craftsmen were able to accomplish the highest quality of work demanded by the building and did so working off hours and weekends to meet the owner's building requirements.
